What: This is a unique opportunity to combine an afternoon arts experience of your choosing with a morning arts education seminar to learn how to apply your art form to a classroom setting. You will select afternoon and/or evening arts classes, offered through the Fairbanks Summer Arts Festival for up to 3 credits. You will join a cadre of educators for your morning seminar through AAEC for an additional 2 ED 593 credits. Together we will deepen our knowledge of how students learn using our own afternoon art experiences, considering brain research and habits of mind, participating with guest artists who share insights on a variety of art forms, and formulating a plan to apply what is learned to our personal school or classroom setting

Costs: Course fees vary for the Fairbanks Summer Arts Festival (see www.fsaf.org). Scholarships of \$500 available on a first-come basis to teachers from AAEC member districts. Payment of \$200 required when registering by June 1. Includes UAF tuition 2 credit fee. Travel, housing and per diem is the responsibility of the participant.
